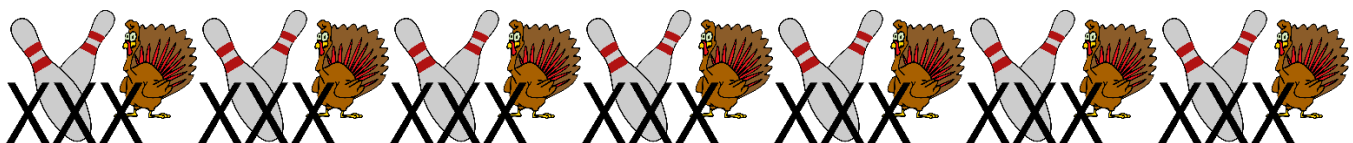

**WISCONSIN AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY STATE BOWLING ASSOCIATION**  
**TOURNAMENT RULES – READ CAREFULLY**

1. All senior members of the Wisconsin American Legion Auxiliary, holding 2018 membership card are eligible to enter the tournament under the below rules.
2. New bowlers enter the tournament with an average of 145.
3. Entrants allowed bowling only once per event.
4. Everyone **MUST** bowl when scheduled.
5. Entries must be accompanied by full amount of fees, **\$17.00 per bowler, per event**. The entry fees cannot be refunded after the entry and fees have been received. Hostess city entrants will be given dates and times requested, **if possible**; otherwise the tournament manager will assign dates and times. **NO** hostess city entries will be refunded.
6. No entries shall be accepted after the entry closing date. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
7. All events are optional and may be entered for a \$2.00 fee. Paid all events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces original entrant in all three events.
8. If a team has only 3 bowlers, only 3 scores can be used. **NO** blind score will be used.
9. This tournament will be conducted on a handicap basis of 75% of the difference between each entrant's average and 200 pins.
10. **If a substitution is made in the doubles event the substitute must take the place of the bowler she is replacing. NO rearranging of partners will be permitted in the doubles.**
11. A sub shall be allowed, if one is available, in case of disability after a game has started, in team and doubles only. Only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count if a sub is not available.
12. Bowlers entered in all three events will be so scheduled to permit them to complete competition within two days, unless they are doubled with someone who is bowling on another four-woman team at some other time, which prevents scheduling of these participants on same convenient dates.
13. Teams will bowl all three games on their scheduled pair of lanes. Doubles and Singles events will be bowled on another pair of lanes.
14. Every bowler entered in the individual events must have at least one ball for her personal use. No sharing balls with other bowlers. (House balls are acceptable.)
15. If a bowler is absent by the scheduled time and does not arrive by the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> frame of the 1<sup>st</sup> game, absent bowler shall forfeit the first game, but is eligible to bowl 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> game if arrival prior to the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> game. This is for Singles and Doubles **ONLY**.
16. Team Champion will receive a plaque for the winning Unit.
17. Cash prizes will be determined upon completion of tournament, based on funds received.
18. **NO SMOKING OR DRINKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BOWLERS SEATING AREA.**
19. Make sure you are watching for your turn to bowl and keep the games going. There are other shifts for Auxiliary bowling and possible league bowling scheduled after our tournament.

**CAPTAINS**

1. Captains must check in and verify lineups **45 minutes** prior to starting time. **Registration will CLOSE 30 minutes before squad time. This is all necessary due to last minute changes. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.**
2. When substitutes not registered on entry blank are used, captains shall report same to Tournament Manager before entering contest and present 2018 American Legion Auxiliary membership card of substitute.
3. There must be a **TEAM CAPTAIN FOR EACH TEAM**.

### **WOULD YOUR UNIT LIKE TO HOST A BOWLING TOURNAMENT?**

#### **REQUIREMENTS FOR HOSTING BOWLING TOURNAMENT**

1. Submit bid to WALASBA Chairman/ Tournament Manager – Name in Red Book (Preferably by September so Board can act on bid – but will accept any time.)
2. Include the following information in bid:
  - a. Name of bowling establishment you have contacted and checked out.  
List name of contact person and phone number at the lanes.
  - b. Number of lanes available (at least 16 required).
  - c. Do they have automatic scoring?
  - d. Name of Unit, County or District hosting event.
  - e. Name, address and phone number of host chairman.
  - f. List of housing nearby, with rates, phone numbers and map of area.  
(This can be submitted once your bid has been accepted)
3. Have Sgt-at-Arms available with Unit Colors if Department doesn't provide theirs.

This is an excellent fundraising opportunity – ask the Post for assistance. Raffles, crafts and 50/50 are very popular or whatever you want to do to raise money. The more the Unit works, the more profits you reap. Get ads for the booklet. Solicit businesses where the ladies and men are likely to shop, eat, etc. and ask if they want to include a discount coupon.

The Post may even want to have a Saturday evening dinner.
