NOMINATION OF DEPARTMENT OFFICERS

Friday, July 15th - morning session

Constitution, Article IV, Section 2: *The following officers shall be elected annually at the Department Convention by a majority of the ballots cast. When there is but one candidate for an office, the nominee can be elected by voice vote or acclamation.*

One (1) Department President

One (1) Senior Vice President

The following officers shall be elected annually at the Department Convention by plurality vote of the ballots cast. When there is but one candidate, the nominee can be elected by voice vote or acclamation.

One (1) First Vice President

One (1) Second Vice President

One (1) Historian

One (1) Chaplain

NOMINATIONS FOR NATIONAL CONVENTION DELEGATES

Friday, July 15th, 9:00 a.m., District Caucus

Constitution, Article VII, Section 2, #6: *Each of the twelve Districts may nominate up to three delegates in a caucus, which shall be called for that purpose at the Department Convention. There shall be no nominations from the convention floor. The requisite number of delegates shall be elected by the convention according to the plurality count. The remaining nominees for delegates automatically become alternates according to the plurality count.*

- Three (3) nominees for National Convention delegate will be chosen at each District Caucus on Friday, July 15th at 9:00 a.m.

National Constitution, Article VI, Section 2: *Representation in the National Convention shall be by Departments. Each Department shall be entitled to five delegates and one additional delegate for each 1,500 members or major fraction thereof, whose current dues have been received by the National Treasurer thirty days prior to the meeting of said Convention, and to one alternate for each delegate. The delegates and alternates shall be selected not less than two weeks before the National Convention at Department Conventions.*
