

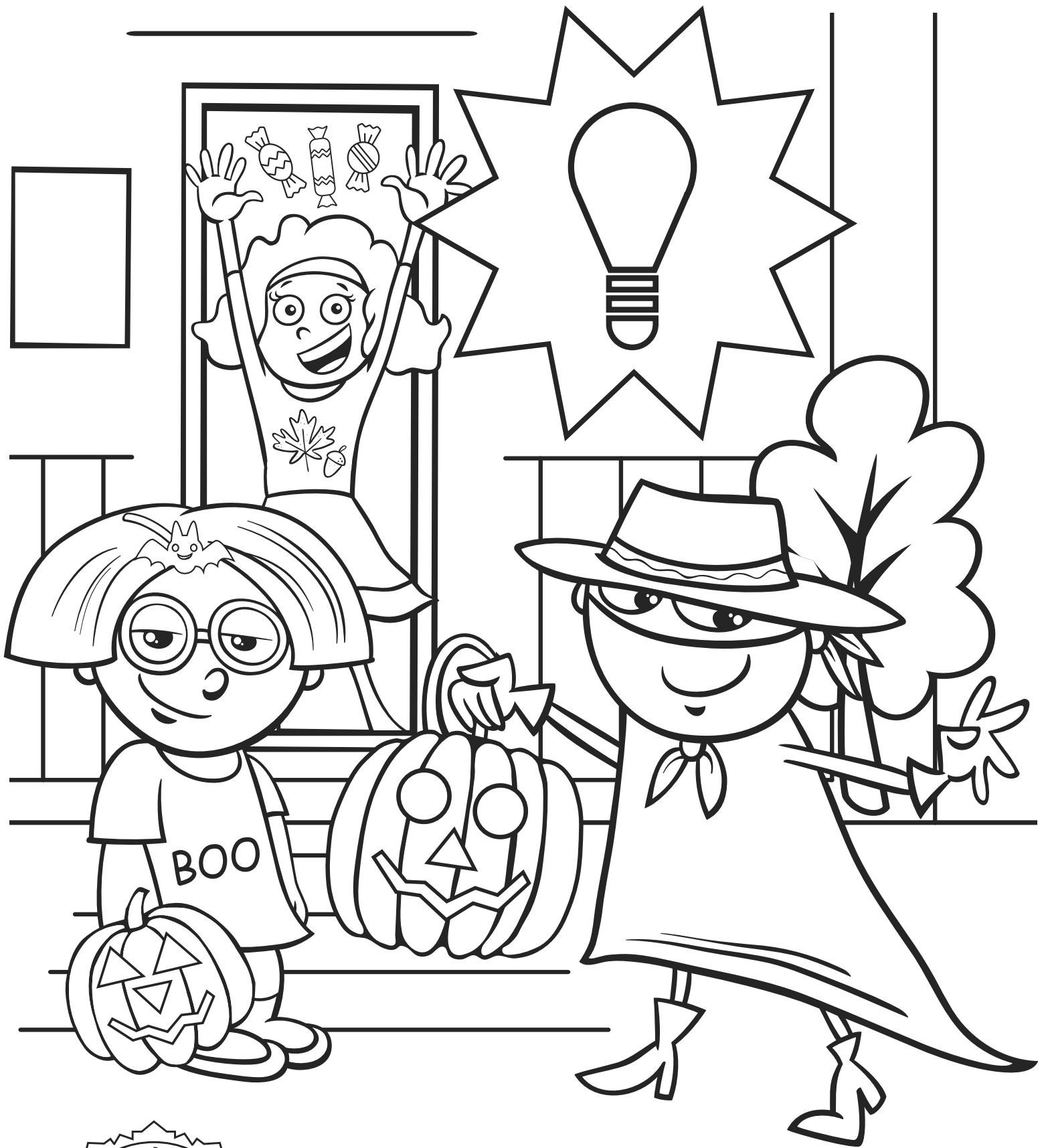


Have A Safe
