# **Americanism Essay Criteria and Rubric**

**35 Points- Theme Development:** This would involve answering the who, what, where, when and why about the theme. Essays should relate to the writer's personal experiences.

**35 Points- Clarity of Ideas:** Essays should have an easy to understand format or organization with correct spelling and grammar usage. The ideas or points are clearly expressed. The reader should have a clear understanding of the writer's explanation of the theme.

**30 Points- Knowledge or Understanding of the Question:** The writer shows an understanding of the key words in the question. (This assists the writer with the task of staying on the topic or the question.)

## **SCORING RUBRIC**

#### 35 Points- Theme Development:

- 25 Points- The writer answers the who, what, where, when and why about them.
- 10 Points- The writer provides personal experiences that relate to the topic.

### 35 Points- Clarity of Ideas:

- 25 Points- The essays should have an easy to understand format or organization so that the reader understands the writer's explanation of the theme. The ideas or points are clearly expressed.
  - \* Grades 5 and up should have an introduction, smooth transitions between ideas and a conclusion.
- 5 Points- The writer uses correct spelling.
- 5 Points-The writer uses correct grammar.

#### 30 Points- Knowledge or Understanding of the Question:

• 30 Points- The writer shows an understanding of the key words in the question. (This assists the writer with the task of staying on the topic or question.)
