DEPARTMENT OF WISCONSIN

Article VI – District Conference Section 2.

The annual Conference shall be comprised of delegates, delegates-at-large, alternates and members from the Units within the District and guests. The District Officers, County Presidents, and Past District Presidents are Delegates-at-large, and delegates from Units with the District, shall have voting power. Alternates shall have, voting power, in the absence of a delegate from their Unit. Each Unit shall be entitled to two delegates and two alternates for the Unit itself, and an additional delegate and alternate for each fifty members or major fraction thereof which it shall have in excess of fifty members, whose Unit's District dues have been paid, and whose State and National dues have been received by the Department Executive Secretary-Treasurer for that year in addition to Delegates-@-Large from each unit.
