Greetings!

I hope that all of you are enjoying the warm weather and sunshine. June has been very nice so far, but we could use a little rain. June is a time to look back over the ALA year and take stock of what we accomplished without having to write a report about it.

MEMBERSHIP

We are doing well on membership this year with 9 units over 100% and 9 units over 90%. There is still time to renew memberships for 2026. However, dues will not be processed between June 22nd and July 6th. National will be updating their software. That being said, please try to get your renewals in before June 22nd. However, you can renew a member for 2026 at any time.

POPPY

I hope that you all had a good time distributing poppies. It is such a good time to make people aware of our organization and what we do. It is not so much about how much we make while distributing the poppies as getting information about the American Legion Auxiliary into the public's hands. I don't know how many of our units distribute at Kwik Trips, but we were told that this would be the last year we would be able to do it there. Something about a corporate policy not allowing it. Please check with your local Kwik Trip so you know for next May.

Also, you need to report your Poppy income to department and pay them the 20% as designated by Department Standing Rules from 1928. If you purchased Poppies and did not distribute them, please fill in the lower part of the form telling what you did with your poppies and send it in also. There is a form in the June/July Unit mailing.

UNIT MAILING

Speaking of the By-Monthly unit mailing, there has been a change. Starting in June the unit mailing will be sent out by subscription only. There will be a \$25.00 subscription fee for June 2026 through June 2027. ALABGS

ALABGS will start on June 21st for the delegates. 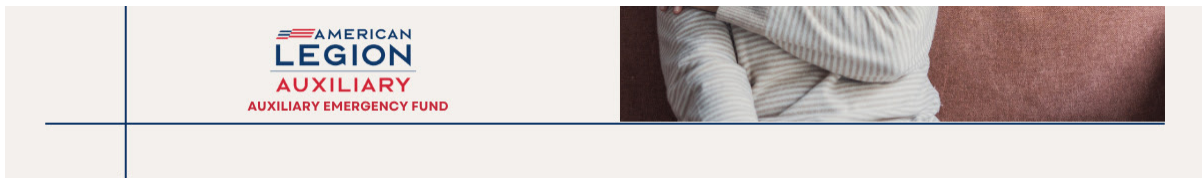

GOOD TO KNOW

ALAMIS (the ALA's management information system/member database) will be undergoing a substantial upgrade that will affect ALAMIS and the MyAuxiliary member portal.

Timeframe:

- ALAMIS and the member portal will be unavailable starting at noon ET June 22. ALAMIS is expected to be back up and running on July 6.

How will this upgrade impact members?

- During this time, membership processing, reports, or payment of dues will not be available. This means that if you call National Headquarters about your member record, we can't change anything because the system is down for staff too.
- Changes to the MyAuxiliary portal for our members will be minimal.
- ALAMIS users will see a new, more intuitive interface when they log in.
