

HOW TO ESTABLISH A PAST PRESIDENTS PARLEY IN YOUR UNIT

- Units are encouraged to establish a Past Presidents Parley (PPP) consisting of their past unit presidents. These groups can continue their support of the organization by using their experience, knowledge and wisdom to be goodwill ambassadors and to strengthen our organization and help maintain its growth.
- PPPs can play an important part in the mentoring of current members to develop knowledgeable leadership within the Unit. They can support and assist in a recruitment effort for new members.
- They should make themselves available to current officers as well as potential candidates for office. Their guidance and constructive feedback should help the unit maintain continuity and good cooperation.
- This group could hold a luncheon during meetings to share current Unit news.
- They may choose to donate or raise funds for PPP nurses scholarships.
- They may discuss making specific donations or how they could assist with issues within their Unit to help create a positive result. A discussion could be held about ideas for proposing a resolution to help clarify a questionable Constitution & Bylaws article.
- They could invite the current department president and any national guest who may be in attendance at their meeting.
