Volunteers Urgently Needed for the Following Positions in Your Community:

Disaster Action Team

As a DAT volunteer, you can help comfort and support people in your community by meeting any immediate needs such as food, shelter, clothing or supplies.

Pillowcase / Pedro the Penguin

These youth programs provide emergency preparedness education to youth in school classrooms and other settings. These classes are focused on home fires.

Blood Drives

Volunteers are cross trained to do several jobs including registering donors (basic computer skills needed) and handing out snacks. Minimum of 4 shifts per year

Disaster Dispatch (Remote)

Disaster response is a team effort and Disaster Dispatch is the vital link between the Red Cross and local first responders.
