The ALA Department Convention

The 2024 American Legion Auxiliary Department Convention will be called into session at the Hilton Paper Valley, 333 West College Avenue, Appleton at 9:30 a.m. on Friday, July 12, 2024.

The purpose of the department convention is to elect officers for the 2024-2025 administrative year; elect delegates and alternates to the national convention; amend the department constitution, bylaws and standing rules as needed; receive reports of the department officers and chairmen; recognize outstanding unit achievements; and transact business as may be brought before the convention body.

Representation in the department convention shall be by unit in accordance with the provisions of the department constitution. Units with less than ten paid members or whose district dues have not been paid shall have no representation. Delegates to department convention shall be unit members duly elected for that purpose.

All attendees to the 2024 Department Convention must submit a registration form and \$30 per person to The American Legion by July 6, 2024. Registrations after July 6th will be \$35.

All delegates must be registered by 8:00 am on Saturday, July 13th and seated within their District for voting at 9:00 am. Business will resume as soon as voting is completed.

Housing has been arranged at the Hilton Paper Valley hotel. Discounted room rates will be available until June 11, 2024 or when the room block is filled, whichever comes first. So please start making your plans as soon as possible.
