GET INVOLVED

- 1. Promote American Legion Family Day on the last Saturday of April.
- 2. Bring awareness to The American Legion's "Be The One" initiative to improve access and reduce the stigma around mental health issues.
- 3. Promote community involvement in American Legion Auxiliary programs:
 - a. Blood Drives, CPR training, and emergency preparedness (National Security program).
 - b. Suggest participation in Child Safety Programs (Children & Youth program).
 - c. Participate in patriotic holidays (Americanism program).
 - d. Develop new ways to reach diverse groups such as age, ethnicity, etc. (Membership program).
 - e. Create visible events in the community that support veterans (VA&R program).
 - f. Participate in Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service.
 - g. Participate in the 9/11 National Day of Service.
