The Sons of The American Legion are male descendants (son, grandson, stepson, or adopted son) of a member of The American Legion. They are a service organization that supports veterans and veterans' causes and strive to serve our State and Nation through community service, support, and programs.

Finally, by becoming a member of The American Legion, if you are a motorcycle enthusiast, you can join The Legion Riders. Members must hold membership in and be in good standing with The American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary or Sons of The American Legion. Members must be legally registered motorcycle owners or be the legally registered owner's spouse within the state of registration. Riders nationwide participate in The American Legion Legacy Run to annually raise money for the Legacy Scholarship Fund, established to provide scholarships to children of U.S. military personnel killed since Sept. 11, 2001.
